The following details relate to an educational Incursion to Constable Kenny – Stay OK In the Community which is being organised for preschool.

Purpose of Incursion: ACT Policing’s Constable Kenny Koala program is designed to educate child care and primary aged children on a range of safety themes, and to encourage them to turn to police for help and advice.

Activities: The preschool children will interact with Constable Kenny, ACT Policing’s mascot and his presenter. They will talk to the students about being safe in the community. They will cover topics such as: how to keep yourself safe, dealing with strangers, and who to speak to if you get into trouble or feel unsafe.
